Material list:

• It is hard to make up a specific materials list because the materials use will depend a lot on the designs of your rings. So, if you have it already I would bring a variety of different size silver wire and sheet.

I will also bring silver wire and sheet in a variety of different gauges that can be purchased from me.

- You can also bring:
- Any stones you may have
- Any small found objects: cool antique buttons or coins, rust metal objects, bottle caps, anything else that may look good on a ring

Tool list:

These are some recommended tools to bring if you own them. I wouldn't go out and purchase them if you don't already own them.

Highly recommended

- Saw frame and blades
- Files – half round and needle
- Safety glasses
- Wet dry sand paper, 320, 400, 600 grit (this is the black kind)
- Designing materials – pencil, paper, templates, etc...
- Pliers and snips
- Ring clamp

Bring them if you got them:

- Scribe
- Burnisher
- Mini Square
- Pen vise
- Reading glasses or optivisors
- Dividers
- A flex shaft – we should have a couple but you might want your own
- Any flex shaft attachment you see fit
- Ring mandrel
- Calipers
- Soldering pick
- Desk lamp
- Masking tape
- Any other of your favorite hand tools that you use on a regular basis
